Jefferson scored a TD but missed the two-point conversion pass in 4Q, as they cut the Tiger lead to (15-13). A late 40-yard FG by the Dragons was just wide left, as the Tigers held on and defeated Jefferson (15-13) for their 12th straight win over the Dragons, (1995-06). C-J Rivalry (41-15-5)

Commerce eclipsed the old Total Points by Both Teams in a Game record of 85 vs. Oconee Co. in 1980 by scoring 95 points in a (55-40) victory over Banks County.

The Team Total Offense record of 553 yards vs. Towns Co. in 1998 was also eclipsed with 567 yds. vs. Banks County. Together, Commerce and Banks Co. had 1015 total yards.

^^^--- SE Cohen Cooke broke the old game receptions record of 9 for the Tigers by catching 10 in each of Trion & Calhoun games.

^^^^--Two 4th quarter TD's and 2-pt conversion overcomes 2 TD deficit.
