^----- In what was probably the greatest defensive effort in Tiger history, Commerce had (4) goal line stands in the second half, three occurred in the fourth quarter. Commerce scored on a 20-yard pass from QB John Fleming to TE Stanley Seagraves. Seagraves kicked the PAT enabling the Tigers to win a squeaker. The coaching staff related that this game with Hart County was the catalyst for the successful decade that lay ahead for the Tigers in the seventies >>(98-16-6) record. .842 pct.

^^----- John Fleming's (68) yard punt held up as the longest in Tiger history until Michael Collins' (70) yard punt in 2000 vs. Lincoln County(2) in the Georgia Dome.

^^^--- The Dragon defense stymied the Tiger offense in Jefferson's Memorial Stadium mud. However, it did not rain during the game.

This loss caused the Tigers to finish 2nd in Sub-region 6A East behind Jefferson. C-J Rivalry (13-7-4)

^^^--- Dragon offense led by QB Jimmy Lofton was too much for the Tigers, as Jefferson recorded its 5th consecutive win over Commerce.

QB Ed Nelson scored a late 4Q Tiger TD with a 5 yard run. This loss caused the Tigers to finish 2nd in Sub-region 6A East. C-J Rivalry (13-8-4)

&&----Runt Moon had an 81-yard KO return for a touchdown. The Tigers held off the late two TD Lion rally in the fourth period and denied FC the late go-ahead touchdown.
