\$----- Jason Pittman's 89-yard fumble return for a TD became the longest in Tiger history; he intercepted the lateral in mid-air and scored untouched. However, the Tigers lost the game by one point after missing all four extra point and 2-point conversion attempts.

\$\$----- The Tigers built a (22-0) lead by halftime behind HB Jason West's 152 yds. rushing and two TD's of 47 and 50 yds. Vernard Gillespie added TD runs of 13 and 22 yards. QB Pittman passed 19-yards to SE Corey Wood and QB Chuck Thompson added a 12-yard TD run. C-J Rivalry (27-13-5)

^----- Tiger second team QB Chuck Thompson passed 15 yards to HB Vernard Gillespie for a game winning TD on the final play of the game to upset Monticello. Starting QB Jason Pittman was not available to play.
