^----- Tigers defeated Jefferson despite having four starters out for disciplinary action. The Tigers led (8-6) going into the fourth period. Stephen David's 9-yard TD run upped the lead to (14-6), but the two-point conversion run failed. Jefferson later threw a 43-yard TD pass. However, the two-point conversion pass was unsuccessful and left the Tigers with a hard-fought (14-12) 4Q victory, as Commerce stopped the late Jefferson rally.

This game was played in a light drizzle.
